## Olive Oil Competition - AIPO D'ARGENTO 2013 Regulation

### Article 1

The A.I.P.O. - Interregional Association of Olive Oil Producers, in collaboration with Unaprol - Italian Olive Oil Consortium, organized in Verona, for the period May to September 2013, the **10th edition of the Olive Oil Competition "AIPO SILVER"** in order to highlight the best domestic, national and international oil productions, highlighting the features aim to involve operators in the domestic and international markets, also in order to promote the qualitative growth of the production of extra virgin olive oil produced in the Mediterranean area. In continuation of this Regulation, the Oil Competition "AIPO SILVER" will be identified with the term "Competition" and / or "event".

### Article 2

The competition is held under the aegis of the Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Forestry, the Ministry of Economic Development of the Italian Republic, the European Union, the IOC (International Olive Oil Council), Veneto, Friuli Venezia Giulia and Trentino Alto Adige, as well as the Union of Veneto, Friuli Venezia Giulia and Trentino Alto Adige

The legal representatives of the Supporting Organizations, or their delegates, will become part of right and of the Management Committee of Trustees, chaired by the President of AIPO.

### Article 3

Are permitted to 10 ° Olive Oil Competition "AIPO SILVER" extra virgin olive oils presented by:

- olive oil producers on their own;
- cooperative oil mills and / or producer organizations;
- holding companies and / or bottling companies-packaging machines, subject to any system of controls or certification holders, in the area of the product ready for release for consumption.

Are excluded from the competition for producers and / or mills that do not meet the requirements referred to in points a), b), c) of this Regulation (Article 1 paragraph. 3).

May participate in the **10th Oil Competition "AIPO SILVER"** only companies that can document that the / s sample / s of extra virgin olive oil is produced in quantities presented not less than 250 kg.

**Olive Oil Competition will be excluded from all samples do not comply with the provisions of this Regulation, and those who do not comply with the payment of administrative fees due (Art. 5).**

### Article 4

The samples presented at the 10th edition of the competition will be included in the following categories:

- 1) extra virgin olive oil DOP;**
- 2) extra virgin olive oil Italian I.O.O.%;**
- 3) extra virgin olive oil produced in the Mediterranean.**

Each of the above categories will in turn, and on the recommendation of a special tasting panel, divided into the following sessions:

- Midly fruity;
- Medium fruity;
- Intensely fruity.

### Article 5

For each sample submitted, the Company competitor must fulfill the following commitments:

- send by courier and / or priority mail, no later than May 10, 2013** to the Organizing Secretariat (AIPO, Viale del Lavoro 52,

37135 Verona • Tel +39 045 8678260), **n. 3 bottles of min. 500 ml.**, Suitably packed to avoid breakage or anything else that could damage the sample that you want to enroll. Each carton containing samples, must affix outside the following text: "SAMPLE NON-COMMERCIAL sent for the 10th Oil Competition" AIPO SILVER "2013"

b) **number 3 labels**, with eventual against labels, identical to those of the sample writing. Alternatively, the above-mentioned material can be sent on CD-ROM (jpg, pdf) and will be used for the construction of the catalog and samples of the participating Companies 2013 edition, also disclosed in the middle of the AIPO site ([www.aipoverona.it](http://www.aipoverona.it));

c) **the application form**, written in capital letters and / or otherwise legibly, signed by the Company's competitors;

d) a **copy of the receipt** for the payment of administrative fees to be made by bank transfer (**IBAN: IT35 N 06225 11701 07406011274A – BIC IBSPIT2P 807**) or, if in cash, paid with the submission of the request by sending the amount in a sealed envelope, to the documentation included with all 'inner packaging containing the sample writing. Payment by bank transfer must result in the issuance of invoice.

The amount of the fees Secretariat is fixed in the following manner:

- € 50.00 + VAT (€ 60.50 including VAT) for a sample of oil;
- € 90.00 + VAT (€ 108.90 including VAT) for a total of two samples of oil;
- € 120,00 + VAT (€ 145.20 including VAT) for a total of three samples of oil;
- € 140,00 + VAT (€ 169.40 including VAT) for a total of four samples of oil;
- € 150,00 + VAT (€ 181.50 including VAT) for a total of five samples of oil;

the sixth sample of oil, and later, the addition for each sample is € **30,00 each.** + VAT.

If the Company requires the billing of the payment made will be applied, the amount due, the VAT law;

e) the **board extra virgin olive oil and business card filled** in legibly in all its parts (letters or typewriter / computer).

Will not be accepted those samples devoid, in whole or in part, the aforesaid material. We will not accept other forms of payment by bank transfer and / or cash.

### Article 6

The organizing secretariat AIPO disclaims any liability:

- for any arrival of the samples after the due date,
- for the total or partial loss of the samples during transport;
- for any organoleptic and physico-chemical changes of the samples due to temperature;
- for cracks, or other malfunctions occurring during transport.

The costs of shipping, customs clearance and subsequent transport to the destination of the package containing the samples shall be borne by the Companies.

Failure to comply with these provisions is grounds for exclusion of / the sample / s from the competition.

The Company will not request the return of the registration fee paid, and the shipment is made to load and total responsibility of the participant who must bear all risks associated.

**The samples sent postage due will be rejected and will not be returned.**

### Article 7

Since receiving the beginning of sensory analysis, it will be the preservation of the Organization, in an appropriate environment, the samples before being submitted to the Committee of taste, made

anonymous and will be adequately marked with a special recognition code.

The head of the Organization shall at the same time legally responsible for the accuracy of all activities and operations preparatory to the final stage of the competition.

For the performance of its functions will benefit, in its sole discretion, the collaboration of staff of their choice.

At the same will head for the entire duration of the competition, compliance with the formal aspects and modes of operation of the same.

It will also be the guarantor of the preservation of samples from the time of their anonymity, to verify the correctness of the partial and final ranking of the competition.

#### Article 8

The Committee of taste is composed of 8 tasters entered in the appropriate register.

The method of evaluation of samples is commonly adopted in similar international competitions.

The activities of the Competition will be preceded by chemical analysis of the samples received, a document that will later be sold, free of charge, the Company participant, if you always up to date with the payment of the Secretariat.

The Committee of taste, coordinated by the panel leader and the head of the Organization of the Competition, will proceed to carry out an initial screening of the oils arrived, taking care to eliminate samples with discrepancies smell / taste and the inclusion of samples in class and / session or expertise.

Each member of the Committee of taste, at any stage of the planned activities, will deliver its judgment and its own values should be expressed in cents.

The final score will be the result of the arithmetic average of the ratings of each member of the Committee of taste expressed in cents.

he judgments of taste Committee are final.

#### Article 9

Go through to the final stage of the competition only those samples that have exceeded the threshold of 93 hundredths of a point.

The samples of each class and session (Article 4) who have obtained the highest score will be awarded the "**AIPO SILVER 2013**".

It will also be awarded the **Diploma of Honour in Silver Punch** with all samples that have received the second highest score in 3 sessions each category.

To all the others, namely to:

- extra virgin olive oil "Garda Bresciano DOP";
- extra virgin olive oil "Garda Orientale DOP";
- extra virgin olive oil "Garda Trentino DOP";
- extra virgin olive oil "Veneto Valpolicella DOP";
- extra virgin olive oil "Veneto Euganei e Berici DOP";
- extra virgin olive oil "Veneto del Grappa Veneto DOP";
- extra virgin olive oil "Laghi Lombardi Sebino Dop";
- extra virgin olive oil "Laghi Lombardi Lario Dop";
- extra virgin olive oil "Tergeste DOP";
- extra virgin olive oil Italian 100%;
- extra virgin olive oil from organic farming;
- extra virgin olive oil produced in the "Mediterranean";

will be awarded the **Diploma of Great Mention** in those samples that have passed, to be entitled to the awards provided (Article 9), **the score of 93/100** and that each of **the above categories and Sessions (art. 4) have been written a minimum of 5 samples.**

To all the participating companies will be recognized, however, the **Certificate of Participation.**

#### Article 10

All samples duly entered in the competition will participate in **the Prize Best Packaging**, based on the opinion expressed by the Commission consists of:

- a restaurateur;
- an expert representing the consumer associations;
- a journalist;

answering machine Contest:

- a graphic designer.

The Commission will be chaired, with the right to vote, the President pro tempore AIPO.

The selection will be made taking into account the following elements:

- a) design, elegance and functionality of the container (bottle), the originality of the label, back label and / or collar, of any box or other item that is an integral part of the packaging;
- b) innovative materials used in the making and who have enhanced the quality, origin of the product, its visibility.

The decision will not be binding on opinions expressed by the Committee of taste of taste or altering in any way the final ranking emerged from the sensory analysis.

#### Article 11

The winners will be the subject of a special event organized dall'AIPO presumably in early October 2013.

Each winning company will receive, via email or otherwise, communication time and the place where the award ceremony will take place.

The award-winning oils will be subject to a special list disclosed by the AIPO in the manner that it deems appropriate.

**Companies participants who have passed the first screening (Article 8) and who will have access to the later stages of the competition, who intend to mention in its own business (while always adhering to the rules in force in each country) will make a written request to the Secretariat of the logo of the competition, to the extent and in the quantities they need, with the payment of a contribution, by way of reimbursement of expenses, €0.10 for each label (sticker) for a minimum order of 200 pieces.**

The awards not collected during the awards ceremony will be requested from the Secretariat by fax or e-mail, who will provide for their shipment at the expense of the recipient.

The AIPO disclaims any liability for any loss or non-delivery.

The Management Committee of the Competition reserves the right to modify these rules at any time if it deems useful to the best event.

For any dispute the jurisdiction is to Verona.
